



Terms and Conditions (Acceptable Use)

IT Inventory

These terms and conditions detail how IT Inventory can be used once purchased. They do NOT provide proof of purchase, your licence agreement with activation key provides you with proof of purchase.

Once purchased, IT Inventory can be used on an unlimited number of computers within the purchasing establishment providing the computers are owned by the purchasing establishment and the software is used on behalf of the purchasing establishment.

IT Inventory is designed to be used to collect information about IT equipment within school, therefore, the main installation needs to be carried out on a single computer as this will become the computer where the central information is stored ("Server"). For schools with a server we recommend the main IT Inventory installation is carried out on your server. Once the main installation is done the workstation installation can be installed to an unlimited number of computers however they need to be able to access the server via a network in order for IT Inventory to run.

To ensure the data entered into IT Inventory is kept safe there is a restriction in place to ensure IT Inventory is only run from one computer at a time. This step is crucial in order to provide data integrity and ensure data corruption does not occur.
